To further the mission of the NAACP, we need our members to speak up and be heard on a variety of state-level issues. Each Oregon citizen is represented in the Oregon Legislature by one senator and one representative. A short and simple email lets them hear your voice. Your participation in democracy is crucial to its survival. And the Oregon Legislative Information System (OLIS) makes it fast and easy to do just that.

Find Your Legislators

If you need to determine who currently represents you, no problem. Simply enter your residential address here. This provides email addresses, phone numbers and websites for your state senator and state representative. It also identities your U.S. congressional district and U.S. representative.

Email Your Legislators

Using the **Find Your Legislators** procedure above gives you the email addresses you need. Alternatively, you can find email addresses using these complete lists of <u>Oregon State Senators</u> and <u>Oregon State Representatives</u>. Let your elected officials know of **your** support for legislation that stands up for **your** values. A few sentences that speak to your thoughts and concerns regarding a particular bill or issue benefits our cause. And be certain, the opposition is not sitting silent.
